Michael Moon, an autistic musician, composer, and performer from Toronto, specializes in the power of sound to “heal and transform”. He has released 4 CD's, two of which are internationally distributed. He also runs a recording studio, specializing in projects of a healing, esoteric or transformational nature.

Michael's miscellany of exotic instruments include: vibraharp, hammered dulcimer, marimba, bells, crystals, slide and rhythm guitar, and drums and percussion. They combine mysteriously with his lead and experimental vocals, creating a unique and magical sound. Recently, Michael's song 'Wake up the World' was a prizewinner in the 2003 Tipperary International Song of Peace songwriting competition in Ireland. His song 'Soul Sister' won a Bardic competition.
